The Witness of Two


Aquila and Priscilla, the witness of fellow workers

Every movement needs leaders, and some of the most effective leaders are couples. James and Ellen White were married on August 30, 1846, and together became two of the most influential leaders in the movement that became the Seventh-day Adventist Church. They preached, taught, corrected, and counselled across North America. The publishing work that James initiated was a driving force in globalizing the Adventist message, and Ellen's writings brought vision and prophetic guidance to members and churches around the world. We might call them the ultimate Adventist "power couple"—a pairing of two highly influential individuals that complement and strengthen one another. The early Christian church also had a power couple— Aquila and Priscilla—who, like James and Ellen, strengthened the church wherever they went.
